

STATIONERY LIST

YEAR 8 - 2021

Please make sure that your child has these items for the first day of school:

GENERAL (required for all subjects)

- Scientific calculator** (Preferred - Casio fx-82AU Plus II – *available for purchase from the school front office or through Champion*). This calculator will be used in Lower School and for Year 11 and 12 Sciences, HASS and non ATAR Maths. Maths ATAR students will also be required to purchase a CAS calculator.
- Diary** for home study
- Pencil case** with pens, lead pencils, highlighters, colour pencils, ruler, glue stick and eraser
- 2 x 5 subject books** with lined file paper and subject dividers
- Plastic sheet protectors**
- USB Flash Drive – 4GB**

SUBJECT SPECIFIC

- Science** - A4 plastic document wallet and A4 96pg exercise book
- Maths** - protractor and A4 display file
- English** - A4 display file, Binder A4 2D Ring, A4 96pg exercise book
- French** - A4 plastic document wallet
- Media** - A4 display file
- Visual Art/Craft** – eraser, 2B or 4B pencil
- Music** - 2B pencil, eraser, ruler
- Instrumental Students** (*not all Class Music students do instrumental*)
 - Ensemble uniform as required (Black bottoms, shoes and white shirt) for Junior Band, Senior Band and Guitar ensemble
 - All black uniform (Shirt, shoes, bottoms) for Jazz Band
 - Instrumental tutor books as required by teacher
- Physical Education** – a shirt to change into for sport. Shirts can be purchased from Haslams Workwear and Embroidery
- Headset** with microphone, or **Earphones** with adaptor can be purchased from Esperance Communications

LOWER SCHOOL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to buy textbooks for my child in Year 7, 8, 9 or 10?

No, although some lower school subjects do have certain stationery requirements and you can check this on their stationery list.

Does my child need stationery?

Yes. If you would like to order stationery online through Campion Education, please refer to their information included with your booklist. However, you are quite welcome to purchase your child's stationery requirements locally if you prefer.

When should I pay the school contributions and charges?

The school will be open for payment of your child's contributions and charges on Monday 25th January 2021. It would be appreciated if contributions and charges could be paid by the end of Term 1, 2021. Please contact the Finance Office if you would like to make alternative arrangements for payment.

Is a concession available?

Yes, if you have a current Centrelink Family Health Care Card, Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran's Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. You need to come into the Front Office at the start of school in 2021 to complete an application form. Please bring your concession card with you and your bank details for the clothing allowance. **NOTE: The concession is only available if you apply during TERM 1, 2021.**
