

YEAR 11 AND 12 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to buy textbooks for my child entering Year 11 or 12?

Yes, if your child is studying certain subjects. *NOTE: Not all subjects require textbooks.* If the subject your child is studying is not on the booklist, then there are no requirements.

Vocational students will have a letter enclosed explaining all the requirements for their course.

How do I order textbooks? CHECK THESE DATES

If you need to buy textbooks please refer to the Campion Education information on the front page of your child's booklist. You need to order online by **Friday 11th December 2020**. Your order will be posted directly to your home address. You may fax or post your order forms, but these must be received by **11th December 2020** or you will incur a late fee.

What if I miss the date for ordering textbooks?

Please see the information regarding late orders provided by Campion Education. You will be charged a late fee up to a maximum of \$17.50.

Does my child need stationery?

Yes. You are required to have basic stationery and this may be obtained locally or you may order online from Campion Education. ***NOTE: All Year 11 and 12 students are required to have a homework diary for the start of the school year.***

When should I pay the school contributions and charges?

The school will be open for payment of your child's contributions and charges on Monday 25th January 2021. It would be appreciated if contributions and charges could be paid by the end of Term 1, 2021. Please contact the Manager of Corporate Services if you would like to make alternative arrangements for payment.

Is a concession available?

Yes, if you have a current Centrelink Family Health Care Card, Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran's Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. You need to come into the Front Office at the start of school in 2021 to complete an application. Please bring your concession card and your bank details for the clothing allowance with you. **The concession is only available if you apply during Term 1, 2021.**
