

Athletics Carnival Points Scoring

Championship events (points also count towards faction totals):

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, long jump, triple jump, high jump, shot put and discus.

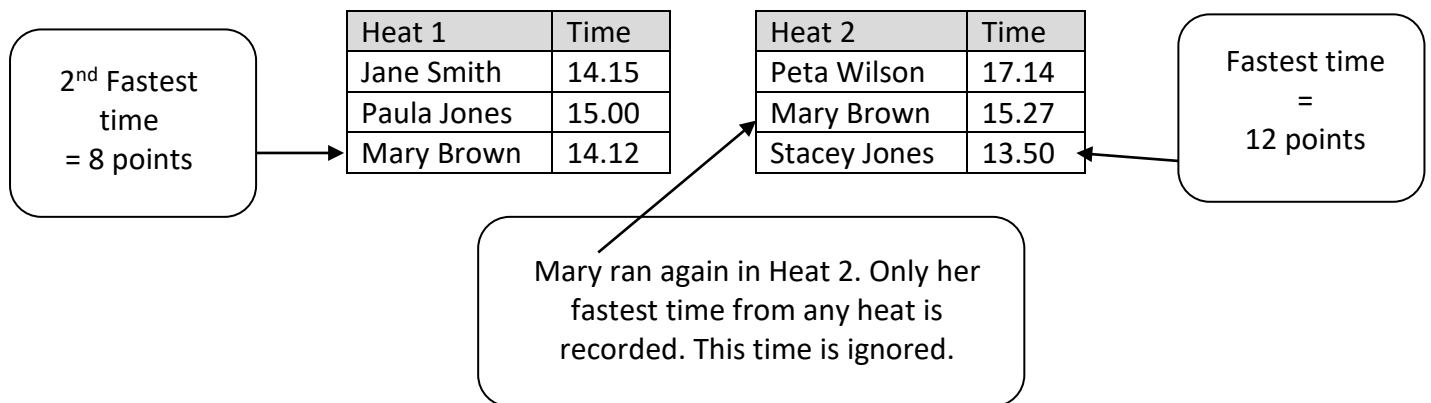
Points are awarded based on fastest times, highest jump, longest jump or furthest throw (depending on the event).

- Fastest, highest, longest etc. = 12 points
- Second fastest, highest, longest etc. = 8 points
- Third fastest, highest, longest etc. = 6 points
- Fourth fastest, highest, longest etc. = 4 points
- 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th fastest, highest, longest etc. = 1 point

Note 1: A student's best result is used regardless of which heat the time was recorded in – all of the data from all of the heats for one event is used together.

Note 2: To eliminate human error in timing it is best if the top competitors compete in the same races – this way timers can see where competitors finish and ensure times recorded reflect this.

Eg. Girls 100m Sprint, 2 heats:



Participation points:

- 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, long jump, triple jump, high jump, shot put and discus
 - 1 point is awarded for participation. Students may participate as many times as they like (or time permits).
 - No additional championship points are awarded for participation.

Relays and novelty events:

- Faction points awarded:
 - 1st = 12 points
 - 2nd = 8 points
 - 3rd = 6 points
 - 4th = 4 points
