How to Stick to a G Rating:

Make sure to reflect the values of the Girls Leadership Project which are Trust, Forgiveness, Compassion, Integrity and Hope. Avoid themes, language, nudity, sex, violence, known characters with reputations, or other matters that the **judges and GLP students** think would offend staff and students at ESHS.

Understand Copyright

Anime culture often encourages the re-creation of existing well-known characters. If you are doing this you should reference the original artist, the name of their character and cite your source on your entry form. For more information about copyright go to our website:
