REFERENCING

When you use information created by other people, you must give them the credit for it. If not, it can be said that you have stolen their work or cheated. This is called **plagiarism** and you will be heavily penalised for doing it.

To avoid plagiarising, you need to create a **list of references** at the end of your work.

Background information to all resources in this guide

Part	Example	Helpful hints
1 Surname of the author, creator or presenter	Richards,	If not stated, write 'unknown'. Social networking sites use the normal name style eg. Allan Richards
2 First name or initials	Allan OR A.W.	Use the whole name or the initials
3 Date published or produced	(2012)	If no date, write 'no date.'
4 Title of the resource	<i>Great Sporting Achievements.</i>	Use italics for the title.
5 Place published	Sydney, N.S.W., Australia:	Not all parts are required.
6 Publisher	Penguin	The company or individual that produced the resource for the market.
